Advanced Stem Courses include Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. They are the building blocks to career success. At Running Brushy 12% of students are enrolled in Algebra 1. Statistically students enrolled in Advanced STEM courses in middle school are successful in their high school careers.

Running Brushy also offers students the opportunity to enroll in college prep courses such as pre Advanced Placement (AP) courses in ELA, PACE Math and pre AP Social Studies. Courses for high school credit include Algebra 1, Spanish, AP Spanish and Project Lead the Way.
